BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 27-105(a) and (c) of Article Transportation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter _____ of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:~~

~~(a) On conviction of any person for a violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland vehicle law that regulate the weight of vehicles on highways, BRIDGES, OR CULVERTS, fines shall be imposed as provided in this section.~~

~~(c) (1) For the first 5,000 pounds of a weight violation over its registered weight or over any statutory OR POSTED weight limit, the fine is the greater of:~~

~~(i) 2 cents for each pound of excess weight; or~~

~~(ii) \$20.~~

~~(2) For a weight violation of a vehicle in excess of 5,000 pounds over its registered weight or over any statutory OR POSTED weight limit, the fine is 6 cents for each additional pound of excess weight over 5,000 pounds.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 27-101(g) be and it is hereby added to Article - Transportation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter 14 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) to read as follows:
