

of able-bodied [male] prisoners in the county jail undergoing punishment under sentence of a court as the county may require, to work on any road in [said] THAT county INCLUDING ANY ROADS, STREETS AND ADJACENT LAND AREAS OF ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY, or in any quarry, pit or yard, in preparing materials for use on the county roads; the county commissioners [are hereby required to] SHALL reimburse the sheriff or other officer out of the county fund for any expenses he may be put to in conveying the [said] prisoners to and from [such] THE road, quarry, pit or yard, or in properly guarding the [said] prisoners while at work on [said] THE road or at [said] THE quarry, pit or yard, under the direction of the county road representative or representatives, and under [such] THE regulations as the sheriff or other officer may deem necessary for their health and safe custody.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
