

NUISANCE BIRDS.

(C) ANY ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE SECRETARY WILL BE ~~EXECUTED~~ PERFORMED SO AS TO PROTECT HUMAN LIFE, DOMESTIC ANIMALS, AND OTHER WILDLIFE.

(D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT ~~RULES~~ AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE MANAGEMENT MEANS AND METHODS OF CONTROL OF NUISANCE BIRDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED IN § 5-804.

5-803.

THE SECRETARY, UPON RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT OF A NUISANCE BIRD PROBLEM, MAY MAKE AN INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE THE DEGREE AND TYPE OF ASSISTANCE REQUIRED. IF NECESSARY AFTER THE INVESTIGATION, THE SECRETARY SHALL RECOMMEND APPROVED MEANS AND METHODS OF POPULATION MANAGEMENT.

5-804.

(A) THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO AID HIM IN ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS WITH RESPECT TO HIS DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) THE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF 11 MEMBERS APPOINTED FOR TWO YEAR TERMS AND SHALL HAVE BALANCED REPRESENTATION FROM FEDERAL AND STATE AGENCIES, AGRICULTURAL INTERESTS, CONSERVATION, EDUCATIONAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL INTERESTS, AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

5-805.

(A) THE SECRETARY SHALL COOPERATE WITH FEDERAL AGENCIES, OTHER STATE AGENCIES, OTHER STATES, AND OTHER PERSONS IN CARRYING OUT THE DUTIES IMPOSED UPON HIM BY THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) ANY MONEY RECEIVED FROM ANY COOPERATOR OR PERSON SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN A SPECIAL NUISANCE BIRD FUND AND BE USED TO DEFRAY PARTIALLY THE EXPENSE OF ~~ENFORCING~~ ADMINISTERING THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
