

THE STATE OF MARYLAND ~~CAN~~ OWNS MORE THAN ONE BUILDING WITHIN 200 FEET OF THE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR WHICH APPLICATION IS MADE, THEN ONLY THE BUILDING OF EACH WHICH IS CLOSEST TO THE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR WHICH APPLICATION IS MADE MAY BE THE BASIS FOR MAKING PROTEST UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 931

(House Bill 228)

AN ACT concerning

Social Services Administration -  
Income Maintenance System

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Social Services Administration to develop and implement a statewide automated income maintenance system.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 3(e) through (g), respectively, of Article 88A - Social Services Administration, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and they are hereby renumbered to be Sections 3(c) through (h), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Section 3(e) be and it is hereby added to Article 88A - Social Services Administration, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:
