

PURPOSES; (2) REAL AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY CRELLIN COMMUNITY CENTER INC., KNOWN AS THE CRELLIN COMMUNITY CENTER AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR COMMUNITY, CIVIC, OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES; AND (3) REAL AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE BITTINGER COMMUNITY CENTER INC., KNOWN AS THE BITTINGER COMMUNITY CENTER, AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR COMMUNITY, CIVIC, OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES; AND (4) REAL AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE GARRETT COUNTY AGRICULTURAL FAIR ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED, AND USED SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE ASSOCIATION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 950

(House Bill 984)

AN ACT concerning

Election Contributions - Questions

FOR the purpose of ~~changing a certain contribution limit;~~ limiting the amount of money or other contributions which certain individuals, associations, and corporations can spend or commit to certain committees for promoting or defeating passage of certain questions, principles, and propositions; and generally relating to campaign contributions.
