RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN CHARTER TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ELECTION BOARD ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST MONDAY IN FEBRUARY IN EACH ODD NUMBERED YEAR AND FURTHER PROVIDING THAT THE TERM OF THE BOARD BEGIN ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN FEBRUARY IN THE YEAR IN WHICH THEY ARE APPOINTED.

RESOLUTION NO. 30

RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 27 OF THE TOWN CHARTER TO REQUIRE CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION TO BE FILED WITH THE ELECTION BOARD ON OR BEFORE THE SECOND MONDAY IN MARCH NEXT PRECEDING THE TOWN ELECTION, TO REQUIRE PETITIONS FOR CANDIDACY TO BE FILED WITH THE ELECTION BOARD AT LEAST 40 DAYS BEFORE THE TOWN ELECTION, AND REQUIRING THE ELECTION BOARD TO CERTIFY CANDIDATES FOR THE REGULAR TOWN ELECTION AT LEAST THIRTY (30) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE SET FOR SUCH ELECTION.
