

SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT HE HAS OBTAINED AND IS COVERED BY THE REQUIRED SECURITY.

(2) IF THE PERSON FAILS TO FURNISH THIS EVIDENCE WITHIN THE 10-DAY PERIOD, THE ADMINISTRATION:

(I) SHALL SUSPEND THE REGISTRATION FOR EACH MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED BY THE PERSON; AND

(II) AFTER A HEARING IS PROVIDED UNDER TITLE 12, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE, MAY SUSPEND THE LICENSE TO DRIVE OF THAT PERSON.

In this section, the term "license to drive" is substituted for the present "driver's license" and the obsolete "operator's license". See §11-128 of this article.

#### 17-106. LAPSE OR TERMINATION OF REQUIRED SECURITY.

##### (A) AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION OF REGISTRATION.

IF THE REQUIRED SECURITY FOR ANY VEHICLE TERMINATES OR OTHERWISE LAPSES AT ANY TIME, THE REGISTRATION OF THAT VEHICLE:

(1) IS SUSPENDED AUTOMATICALLY AS OF THE DATE OF TERMINATION OR LAPSE; AND

(2) REMAINS SUSPENDED UNTIL THE REQUIRED SECURITY IS REPLACED.

##### (B) NOTIFICATION TO ADMINISTRATION OF LAPSE.

EACH INSURER OR OTHER PROVIDER OF REQUIRED SECURITY IMMEDIATELY SHALL NOTIFY THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE TERMINATION OR OTHER LAPSE OF ANY REQUIRED SECURITY ISSUED TO OR PROVIDED FOR A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE.

##### (C) ADMINISTRATION TO NOTIFY OWNER OF SUSPENSION.

ON RECEIPT OF A NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAKE A REASONABLE EFFORT TO NOTIFY THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE THAT HIS REGISTRATION HAS BEEN SUSPENDED.

##### (D) OWNER TO SURRENDER EVIDENCES OF REGISTRATION.

(1) WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER AN OWNER IS NOTIFIED BY THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE SUSPENSION OF REGISTRATION, THE OWNER SHALL SURRENDER ALL EVIDENCES OF THAT REGISTRATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION.
