

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE, EACH COUNTY BOARD, AT ITS ANNUAL MEETING, SHALL ELECT A PRESIDENT AND A VICE PRESIDENT FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.

(E) MEETINGS TO BE PUBLIC.

(1) ALL FINAL ACTIONS OF A COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING. THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.

(2) A COUNTY BOARD MAY MEET AND DELIBERATE IN EXECUTIVE SESSION IF THE MATTER UNDER CONSIDERATION IS:

(I) LAND AND SITE ACQUISITIONS; OR

(II) PERSONNEL AND LABOR RELATIONS.

(F) COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT FOR EXPENSES.

(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE, A MEMBER OF A COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION.

(2) EACH MEMBER SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR TRAVELING AND OTHER EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES.

(3) EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES SHALL RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS ANNUALLY FOR TRAVELING AND OTHER EXPENSES:

(I) CALVERT COUNTY:

- 1. MEMBER.....\$ 1,000; AND
- 2. PRESIDENT.....\$ 1,200;

(II) CAROLINE COUNTY:

- 1. MEMBER.....\$ 400; AND
- 2. CHAIRMAN.....\$ 500;

(III) CECIL COUNTY:

- 1. MEMBER.....\$ 600; AND
- 2. CHAIRMAN.....\$ 800;

(IV) GARRETT COUNTY\$ 200;

(V) QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY:

- 1. MEMBER.....\$ 600; AND
- 2. CHAIRMAN.....\$ 800;
