SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section (s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-310.

(1) THE SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY AND EACH COUNTY, ~~IMMEDIATELY ON QUALIFICATION,~~ MAY APPOINT, ~~FROM TIME TO TIME,~~ FROM AMONG HIS DEPUTIES A SECOND IN COMMAND. ON THE DEATH, DISQUALIFICATION, OR RESIGNATION OF THE SHERIFF OR IN THE EVENT THE SHERIFF IS CONVICTED OF A FELONY, THE SECOND IN COMMAND SHALL SUCCEED TO ALL THE POWERS, DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE SHERIFF UNTIL A SUCCESSOR HAS BEEN APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

(2) IMMEDIATELY UPON ASSUMING THE POWERS OF THE SHERIFF, THE SECOND IN COMMAND SHALL FILE A BOND WITH THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY OR OF THE COUNTY, IN THE SAME PENALTY AND ON THE SAME CONDITIONS AS THAT REQUIRED OF THE SHERIFF.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
