

Each employer (employee) (or in the case of death his family or dependents) entitled to receive compensation under this article shall receive the same in accordance with the following schedule and except as in this article otherwise provided, such payment shall be in lieu of any and all rights of action whatsoever against any person whomsoever.

(3) (f) For other mutilations and disfigurements not hereinbefore provided for, compensation shall be allowed in the discretion of the Commission, for not more than [one hundred] ~~200~~ 156 weeks, as the Commission may fix, in each case having due regard to the character of the mutilation and disfigurement as compared with mutilation and injury hereinbefore specifically provided for.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

(House Bill 1704)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - State's Attorney's Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney in Garrett County; and specifying that the change does not affect the incumbent.
