SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 43 - Health

122.

(b) The following persons may practice without a license, but subject to rules, regulations and orders of the Board and Commission:

(8) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS RECEIVED A MASTER'S DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, INCLUDING COMPLETION OF A GRADUATE PROGRAM IN A BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE WHICH INCLUDED 1,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPY EXPERIENCE ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD, UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED ~~PHYSICIAN~~ PSYCHIATRIST.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
