

JURISDICTION UPON APPLICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT ACTING THROUGH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

(B) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY ~~REGULATION~~, PERMIT, OR ORDER ISSUED THEREUNDER, IS LIABLE TO A PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000, AS WELL AS BEING SUBJECT TO BEING ENJOINED AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A). THE MONETARY PENALTY THUS PROVIDED MAY BE RECOVERED IN A CIVIL ACTION BY THE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

8-8A-09. CONSTRUCTION OF SUBTITLE.

(A) THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE LIBERALLY CONSTRUED TO EFFECTUATE ITS INTENS AND PURPOSES.

(B) THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO BE IN DEROGATION OF ANY POWERS OR STATE LAWS ~~IN EXISTENCE ON JULY 1, 1978~~, BUT SHALL BE REGARDED AS SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO POWERS CONFERRED BY OTHER LAWS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

(Senate Bill 1156)

AN ACT concerning

Retirement Systems

FOR the purpose of deleting certain provisions that relate to membership in the Employees' Retirement System, to participation in certain local retirement systems by certain persons, and to certain prior service credit; clarifying certain provisions that relate to termination of membership; clarifying and renumbering certain provisions that relate to regaining of certain credit; numbering certain provisions; and generally relating to certain retirement systems.
