SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

11-113.1.

"DOMICILE" MEANS THE PLACE OF A PERSON'S TRUE, FIXED, PERMANENT HOME, WITHOUT ANY PRESENT INTENTION OF COMPLETELY ABANDONING THAT HOME, AND TO WHICH HE HAS THE INTENTION OF ~~WHENEVER RETURNING~~ RETURNING WHENEVER ABSENT. DOMICILE DOES NOT INCLUDE A TEMPORARY DWELLING UNLESS THERE IS A PRESENT INTENTION TO ABANDON PERMANENTLY OR INDEFINITELY THE FORMER DOMICILE.

"Resident" means any person:

(1) Who is [a legal resident of] DOMICILED IN this State; OR

(2) Who owns, maintains, or operates a place of business in this State and uses motor vehicles intrastate in that business in this State [;

(3) Who maintains a temporary residence in this State and accepts any employment or engages in any trade, profession, or occupation in this State; or

(4) Who maintains a temporary or seasonal residence in this State in excess of 120 cumulative days during the registration year].
