

STATE TO ELECT ONE (1) MALE AND ONE (1) FEMALE DELEGATE FROM EACH DISTRICT. THE CAUCUS SHALL BE CALLED AND CONDUCTED IN A MANNER AUTHORIZED BY THE RULES ADOPTED FOR THE CONFERENCE BY THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE. THE DELEGATES-AT-LARGE MAY BE ELECTED BY THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OR IN ANY OTHER MANNER ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE. ALTERNATES MAY BE SELECTED AND VACANCIES MAY BE FILLED BY THE ELECTED DELEGATES OR BY A METHOD ADOPTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF MARYLAND CONSISTENT WITH GUIDELINES OF THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all laws and parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are suspended for the period during which this Act has application.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 646

(House Bill 1057)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Minimum Sewer Assessment

FOR the purpose of requiring within a certain sanitary district a minimum assessment upon property abutting upon a street, road, lane, alley, or right-of-way in which a sewer has been built.

BY adding to

Article 43 - Health

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
