42D.

(D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE MAY AUTHORIZE PAYMENT UNDER THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ON A COST RELATED BASIS FOR CARE IN A DAY CARE CENTER FOR THE ELDERLY OR MEDICALLY HANDICAPPED ADULTS, AS PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 717A THROUGH 717J OF THIS ARTICLE, EQUIPPED TO RENDER MEDICAL CARE FOR ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS WHO ARE CERTIFIED AS REQUIRING NURSING HOME CARE UNDER THE PROGRAM.

(2) THESE PAYMENTS SHALL BE MADE SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FEDERAL FUNDS. THE PAYMENT RATE FOR MEDICAL DAY CARE SHALL NOT EXCEED 75 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM PER DIEM RATE UNDER THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR COMPREHENSIVE LONG TERM CARE FACILITIES, AND SHALL INCLUDE COSTS AS REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- (I) PERSONNEL;
- (II) TRANSPORTATION;
- (III) DRUGS, SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT;
- (IV) FOOD;
- (V) ADMINISTRATIVE OVERHEAD; AND
- (VI) MEDICAL AND REHABILITATIVE SERVICES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, ~~1978~~ 1979.
