AN ACT concerning

Property Tax Assessment Appeal Boards - Counties
Alternate Members

~~FOR the purpose of authorizing the appointment of alternate members for the property tax assessment appeal boards, in the counties, except Baltimore City; providing for the method and term of appointment; providing that an alternate member shall sit on a board as the Administrator of the appeal boards deems necessary; and providing that this Act is an emergency measure.~~

FOR the purpose of authorizing the appointment of an alternate member for the property tax assessment appeal boards in each county and Baltimore City; providing for the method of appointment of the alternate; specifying the conditions when the alternate member may serve on the board; providing for the term of office of the alternate member and that the alternate may succeed to a vacancy until the vacancy is filled; providing for the rate of compensation of the alternate member; clarifying language; and relating to membership on the property tax assessment appeal boards.
