

(C) QUALIFICATIONS.

(1) EACH MEMBER SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE.

(2) TWO OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE STUDENTS AT DIFFERENT CAMPUSES OF THE UNIVERSITY, EACH OF WHOM HAS THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED TO BE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT AT THE CAMPUS HE ATTENDS.

(3) ONE OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE THE STATE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE EX OFFICIO.

(D) APPOINTMENT.

EXCEPT FOR THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE, EACH MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

(E) TERM AND VACANCIES; REAPPOINTMENT.

(1) EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBERS, EACH APPOINTED MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF 5 YEARS FROM THE FIRST MONDAY IN JUNE OF THE YEAR OF HIS APPOINTMENT AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON JULY 1, 1978. THESE MEMBERS MAY BE REAPPOINTED.

(2) EACH STUDENT MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF 1 YEAR, FROM JULY 1, AND MAY BE REAPPOINTED IF HE REMAINS A STUDENT AT ANY CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY.

(3) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(F) TWO-TERM LIMIT.

EXCEPT FOR THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE, A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE FULL TERMS.

(G) COMPENSATION.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

(1) SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.
