FOR the purpose of specifying the manner of appropriating in the State budget bill certain expenditures relating to the maintenance and operation of the official residence of the Governor, Government House; providing for the manner of disbursing and accounting for these expenditures of the Governor and Government House; relating to appropriations and expenditures for the Governor and Government House; and providing for an effective date.

This bill specifies the manner in which the appropriations for maintenance and operation of Government House shall be made.

I have today vetoed House Bill 1007, which is a duplicate measure. For the same reasons given in the veto message accompanying House Bill 1007, I have decided to veto Senate Bill 601.
