

EACH BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY FIX THE SALARIES AND TENURE OF THE PRESIDENT, FACULTY, AND OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

(E) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.

EACH BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY PURCHASE, LEASE, CONDEMN, OR OTHERWISE ACQUIRE ANY PROPERTY IT CONSIDERS NECESSARY FOR THE OPERATION OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

(F) DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY.

(1) EACH BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY SELL, LEASE, OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE ASSETS OR PROPERTY.

(2) THE PRESIDENT OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY EXECUTE A CONVEYANCE OR OTHER LEGAL DOCUMENT UNDER AN APPROPRIATE RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD.

(G) COOPERATIVE USE OF FACILITIES WITH BOARD OF EDUCATION.

EACH BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY:

(1) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE BOARD OF FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES, PERMIT THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO USE THE LANDS, BUILDINGS, OR OTHER FACILITIES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND

(2) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, USE ANY LAND, BUILDINGS, ASSETS, OR OTHER
