

QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE BOARD AS OF JULY 1, 1978.

(II) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM IS APPOINTED BY THE BODY THAT APPOINTED HIS PREDECESSOR AND SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) (I) EACH YEAR, THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL ELECT ONE OF ITS MEMBERS AS ITS CHAIRMAN.

(II) THE COMMITTEE MAY ELECT ANY OTHER OFFICER IT REQUIRES.

(III) THE COMMITTEE MAY DETERMINE THE PLACE OF ITS MEETINGS AND ADOPT RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS MEETINGS.

(D) PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION.

(1) THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL:

(I) NOTIFY THE PUBLIC OF EACH VACANCY ON THE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRUSTEES;

(II) OBTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE FACULTY AND STUDENTS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND FROM OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS; AND

(III) ACCEPT APPLICATIONS.

(2) THE COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR THE NAMES OF AT LEAST TWO, BUT NOT MORE THAN FOUR OF THE CANDIDATES SELECTED BY THE COMMITTEE:

(I) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15 OF THE YEAR BEFORE THE TERM OF A NONSTUDENT MEMBER EXPIRES;

(II) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 15 OF EACH YEAR THE TERM OF A STUDENT MEMBER EXPIRES; AND

(III) WHEN ANY OTHER VACANCY OCCURS.

(E) ASSISTANCE TO COMMITTEE.

THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77A, §§9(f) and 9E.

The last clause of the fourth sentence of present Art. 77A, §9(f), which provides for the appointment of the first student member is deleted as obsolete.
