

THIS TITLE;

(2) ISSUE PUBLIC INFORMATION ABOUT THESE SCHOLARSHIPS;

(3) REGULATE THE FORM AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS; AND

(4) CONDUCT CONFERENCES AND INTERVIEWS WITH APPLICANTS TO EVALUATE THEIR ELIGIBILITY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as the first five clauses of the first sentence of Art. 77A, §55.

The last clause of the first sentence of present Art. 77A, §55, which provides for examination and selection of applicants, now appears in subsection (e) of this section.

The only other changes are in style.

(C) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE BOARD MAY ADOPT ANY RULE OR REGULATION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from the last sentence of Art. 77A, §55.

(D) FEDERAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

THE BOARD:

(1) SHALL ADMINISTER ANY FEDERAL PROGRAM OF SCHOLARSHIPS OR GRANTS TO STUDENTS OR INSTITUTIONS; AND

(2) MAY DO ANYTHING NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH ANY FEDERAL LAW RELATING TO THESE SCHOLARSHIPS OR GRANTS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77A, §56.

(E) EXAMINATIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) ARRANGE FOR THE COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION REQUIRED OF APPLICANTS FOR CERTAIN SCHOLARSHIPS; AND

(2) SEND THE RESULTS OF THE EXAMINATION TO THE APPROPRIATE INSTITUTIONS AND TO THE PERSON WHO AWARDS THE SCHOLARSHIP.
