

PLAN, SPECIFICATION, PROPOSAL, OR CHANGE ORDER, HE SHALL STATE IN WRITING THE REASONS FOR HIS DISAPPROVAL.

(3) IF THE CONSTRUCTION IS TO BE DONE BY A COUNTY BOARD, THE BOARD MAY NOT BEGIN UNTIL THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS ARE APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

(4) IF THE CONSTRUCTION IS TO BE DONE BY CONTRACT, THE CONTRACT IS INVALID WITHOUT THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

(G) CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS.

(1) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL CERTIFICATE THE PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE AND SUBJECT TO THE BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD.

(2) RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ANY TEACHER CERTIFICATED MAY BE WAIVED FOR A TEACHER WHO:

(I) IS 55 YEARS OLD OR OLDER; AND

(II) HAS BEEN EMPLOYED IN PUBLIC OR APPROVED NONPUBLIC SCHOOL SERVICE FOR AT LEAST 20 YEARS.

(H) APPROVAL AND CERTIFICATION OF PROGRAMS OFFERED BY STATE INSTITUTIONS.

(1) IF THE PROGRAM IS BASED ON AND COMPLIES WITH STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL APPROVE ANY PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION OFFERED BY A STATE INSTITUTION UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF:

(I) THE JUVENILE SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OR MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;

(II) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES; OR

(III) THE RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL LOCATED WITHIN THE INSTITUTE OF PSYCHIATRY AND HUMAN BEHAVIOR OF THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL.
