### 3-702. COMPENSATION.

#### (A) ALLOWANCES FOR ELECTED MEMBERS.

AN ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD WHO IS SERVING A TERM OF OFFICE THAT BEGAN BEFORE NOVEMBER 30, 1978 MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR HIS SERVICES BUT IS ENTITLED TO AN ALLOWANCE OF \$6,000 ANNUALLY OR ANY LARGER SUM FOR TRAVEL AND OTHER EXPENSES AS PROVIDED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL.

(B) COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED MEMBERS TAKING OFFICE AFTER NOVEMBER 30, 1978.

(1) AN ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD WHOSE CURRENT FULL TERM OF OFFICE BEGINS BEGAN ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 30, 1978 IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE \$7,200 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION INSTEAD OF ALLOWANCES AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD IF ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS ENTITLED TO AN ADDITIONAL \$800 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION.

(2) A MEMBER RECEIVING ANNUAL COMPENSATION ALSO IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES AS APPROVED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL.

#### (C) STUDENT MEMBER.

THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT, AFTER SUBMITTING VOUCHERS, IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSE VOUCHERS, MAY BE REIMBURSED, BUT ONLY FOR OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS CONNECTION WITH OFFICIAL DUTIES.

### 3-703. MEETINGS.

#### (A) ACTIONS TO BE PUBLIC.

ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AFTER A PUBLIC MEETING AND A, THE RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS WHICH SHALL BE MADE PUBLIC.
