(C) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTROLOGISTS.

(D) DEPARTMENT.

"DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

(E) ELECTROLOGIST.

"ELECTROLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PRACTICES ELECTROLOGY.

(F) INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST.

"INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PRACTICES ELECTROLOGY AND TEACHES THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY.

(G) LICENSE.

"LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY OR TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY AND TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY.

(H) LICENSED ELECTROLOGIST.

"LICENSED ELECTROLOGIST" MEANS AN ELECTROLOGIST WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY.

(I) LICENSED INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST.

"LICENSED INSTRUCTOR ELECTROLOGIST" MEANS AN ELECTROLOGIST WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY AND TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY.

(J) PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY.

"PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY" MEANS TO PERFORM ACTS THAT REQUIRE SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE, JUDGMENT, AND SKILL TO REMOVE HAIR PERMANENTLY THROUGH THE USE OF ELECTRICAL INSTRUMENTS.

(K) SECRETARY.

"SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
