Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 1023.

This bill defines "industrial building" to include commercial office buildings and ancillary facilities used and operated in Anne Arundel County.

House Bill 898, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, 1979, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1023.
