AN ACT concerning

The Board of Public Works - Contracts
Subject to Board Approval

FOR the purpose of providing that the requirement that contracts for the expenditure of the proceeds of a loan authorized by the General Assembly shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works before they are executed, does not apply if otherwise provided by law; providing that the Board of Public Works may adopt regulations, subject to approval by a certain committee, by which State departments, boards, commissions, or other agencies may enter into capital project related contracts and change orders prior to or without Board of Public Works approval under certain conditions specified in the Act; and clarifying language.
