In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1000.

This bill changes the procedure for payment of physicians and hospital bills for victims of rape or sexual offense.

I have today vetoed Senate Bill 552, which would accomplish essentially the same purpose as this bill. For the same reasons given in the veto message accompanying Senate Bill 552, I have decided to veto House Bill 1000.
