Provisions of Limited Duration. For the purpose of providing for provisions of limited duration which implement a Constitutional amendment; providing for a new article in the Constitution under which all provisions of limited duration shall be placed; providing that all provisions under the new article shall cease to be a part of the Constitution in accordance with its own terms; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 394,063 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 680 and 124,186 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 680, the said Chapter 680 of the Acts of 1977 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of the State of Maryland.
