(4) IF THE COMMISSIONER FAILS TO DETERMINE RATES LESS THAN THE FIXED MINIMUM WAGE AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION FOR AN INDIVIDUAL "SHELTERED WORKSHOP" OR "WORK ACTIVITIES CENTER" AND IF A CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR IS NOT APPLICABLE, THAT INDIVIDUAL "SHELTERED WORKSHOP" OR "WORK ACTIVITIES CENTER" MAY REQUEST AN EXEMPTION FROM THE COMMISSIONER. AFTER INVESTIGATION AND HEARING, THE COMMISSIONER MAY EXEMPT THAT INDIVIDUAL "SHELTERED WORKSHOP" OR "WORK ACTIVITIES CENTER" FROM THE FIXED MINIMUM WAGE PROVISIONS UNDER THE WAGE AND HOUR LAW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
