SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

[(a) A State Commission to be known as "The Ocean City Convention Hall Commission" is created as part of the Department of Economic and Community Development, with members, duties, powers and functions provided in this section.

(b) The Commission shall have five members to be appointed by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, with the approval of the Governor, for terms of five years. The Secretary of Economic and Community Development, with the approval of the Governor, shall name one member as chairman and the Commission shall elect a vice-chairman at its first organizational meeting. At least two of the members shall be either residents or owners of real property within the corporate limits of Ocean City. The presence of three members at any meeting shall be a quorum.
