79B. JOHN HANSON'S BIRTHDAY.

THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM APRIL 13 OF EACH YEAR AS JOHN HANSON'S BIRTHDAY AND DEDICATE THAT DAY TO THE STATESMAN.
