

subject to approval by Congress unless prior congressional approval has been given. Duly authenticated copies of this compact and of such supplementary agreements as may be entered into shall, at the time of their approval, be deposited with each of the party states and with the [Civil Defense] FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND--CIVIL-DEFENSE Agency and other appropriate agencies of the United States government.

The Governor is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and execute, on behalf of the State of Maryland, such [civil defense] EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE compacts with other states, possessions or territories of the United States or with the District of Columbia, substantially in the form hereinbefore set forth, provided that the Board of Public Works, with the concurrence of the Director of [Civil Defense] THE STATE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY, may approve alterations of the terms, provisions and conditions of the aforesaid proposed [civil defense] EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE compact so long as said alterations are in substantial compliance with the terms, provisions and conditions hereinbefore set forth and when the Governor, in the exercise of the power as aforesaid, enters into and executes [a civil defense] AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE compact on behalf of the State of Maryland, said compact is hereby approved and ratified and every paragraph, clause, provision, matter and thing in the said compact contained shall be obligatory on this State and the citizens thereof, and shall be forever faithfully and inviolably observed, and kept by the government of this State and all of its citizens according to the true intent and meaning of the said compact.

The Secretary of State is authorized and directed to prepare and transmit duly authenticated copies of such compacts and of this act to the governor of each state entering into such compacts, the President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Federal [Civil Defense Administrator] EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND--CIVIL-DEFENSE AGENCY DIRECTOR, the Secretary of State of the United States, and the Council of State Governments.

#### Article 56 - Licenses

(13) Constructing, repairing or remodeling any fallout shelter with knowledge that the work does not conform to the minimum applicable standards of protection to
