TITLE 12. PHARMACISTS AND PHARMACIES.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

12-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER.

"AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER" MEANS ANY LICENSED DENTIST, LICENSED PHYSICIAN, LICENSED PODIATRIST, OR LICENSED ~~VETERINARIAN,--OR--OTHER--INDIVIDUAL--AUTHORIZED--BY--LAW--TO~~ VETERINARIAN.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to replace the various, unnecessarily diverse references throughout the present law to those who may issue prescriptions. See the General Revisor's Note to this title.

(C) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

(D) DEVICE.

(1) "DEVICE" MEANS A DEVICE USED IN THE DIAGNOSIS, TREATMENT, OR PREVENTION OF DISEASE.

(2) "DEVICE" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY:

(I) SURGICAL OR DENTAL INSTRUMENT;

(II) PHYSICAL THERAPY EQUIPMENT;
