

## (3) THE CHART SHALL:

(I) LIST, EXCEPT FOR CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES, THE 100 MOST COMMONLY PRESCRIBED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS BY NAME, MANUFACTURER OR DISTRIBUTOR, STRENGTH, AND QUANTITY;

(II) INCLUDE, WHERE APPROPRIATE, GENERIC EQUIVALENTS OF EACH LISTED PRESCRIPTION DRUG, IF AVAILABLE;

(III) CONTAIN A SPACE IN WHICH THE PRESCRIPTION PRICE OF EACH LISTED PRESCRIPTION DRUG CAN BE INSERTED;

(IV) LIST PROFESSIONAL AND CONVENIENCE SERVICES, AND CONTAIN A SPACE IN WHICH TO INDICATE:

1. WHETHER EACH SERVICE IS AVAILABLE; AND

2. THE ADDITIONAL CHARGE, IF ANY, FOR EACH SERVICE; AND

(V) GIVE ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES.

## (C) LISTING OF PRICES.

EACH PHARMACY SHALL MARK CLEARLY ON THE CHART:

(1) THE PRESCRIPTION PRICE CHARGED BY THE PHARMACY FOR EACH OF THE LISTED DRUGS;

(2) WHICH OF THE PROFESSIONAL OR CONVENIENCE SERVICES THE PHARMACY OFFERS; AND

(3) ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGE THAT THE PHARMACY MAKES FOR EACH PROFESSIONAL OR CONVENIENCE SERVICE IT OFFERS.

## (D) DISPLAY OF CHART.

THE COMPLETED CHART SHALL BE DISPLAYED CONSPICUOUSLY IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG SERVICE AREA SO THAT CUSTOMERS CAN READ IT EASILY WITHOUT THE NEED TO OBTAIN PERMISSION OR ASSISTANCE FROM THE PERSONNEL OF THE ESTABLISHMENT IN WHICH THE PHARMACY IS LOCATED.

## (E) PRICE CHANGES.

A PHARMACY MAY CHANGE THE PRESCRIPTION PRICE OF A LISTED DRUG ONLY IF THE DISPLAYED PRICE IS ADJUSTED TO REFLECT THE NEW PRESCRIPTION PRICE AT THE SAME TIME.
