PART V. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

7-224. PROHIBITED ACTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PERMITTED IN TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON MAY NOT STORE, DISCHARGE, OR DISPOSE OF A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE IN THIS STATE EXCEPT:

(1) IN A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE FACILITY; AND

(2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE.

~~A PERSON MAY NOT TREAT, STORE, DISCHARGE, OR DISPOSE OF LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE IN THIS STATE EXCEPT-~~

~~(1) IN A LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE FACILITY, AND~~

(2) IN TREAT OR DISCHARGE LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE OR ESTABLISH OR OPERATE A FACILITY FOR THE PERMANENT STORAGE OR DISPOSAL OF LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE EXCEPT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.
