(A) IN THIS SECTION THE TERM "MOTORCYCLE" INCLUDES CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLES THAT ARE DESIGNATED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR.

[(a)] (B) Every motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle, shall be equipped with at least two head lamps with at least one on each side of the front of the motor vehicle, which head lamps shall emit white light and comply with the requirements and limitations set forth in this title.

[(b)] (C) Every motorcycle shall be equipped with at least one and not more than two head lamps that comply with the requirements and limitations of this title.

[(c)] (D) Every head lamp on every motor vehicle, including every motorcycle, shall be located at a height of not more than 54 inches nor less than 24 inches.
