FOR--the--purpose--of--providing--that--certain--volunteer
personnel--in--Washington--County--are--considered--workmen
for--wages--and--engaged--in--extra-hazardous--activity
within--the--meaning--of--the--Workmen's--Compensation--Law,
permitting--the--Washington--County--Commissioners--and
individual--volunteer--groups--in--Washington--County--to
secure--and--pay--for--Workmen's--Compensation--for
individual--volunteer--groups,--permitting--the--Washington
County--Commissioners--to--limit--the--number--of--volunteer
personnel--in--a--group--who--are--eligible--for--Workmen's
Compensation,--and--generally--relating--to--workmen's
compensation--coverage--for--certain--volunteer--personnel
in--Washington--County.

FOR the purpose of providing that the Board of County
Commissioners of Washington County may provide for
coverage under the Workmen's Compensation Act of
members of volunteer fire companies and rescue squads.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland
read(s) as follows:

Article 101 - Workmen's Compensation

COMPENSATION-FOR-MEMBERS-OF-VOLUNTEER-FIRE-AND-RESCUE-SQUADS
IN-THE-COUNTY.
