

(1) Filed with the Secretary [an audited] A financial statement THAT IS REVIEWED BY A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT establishing that the applicant's grain business has a net worth of at least \$100,000; [or]

(2) Filed with the Secretary a letter from a [licensed CPA attesting that his examination] CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT STATING THAT A REVIEW of the records of the applicant's grain business shows a net worth of at least \$100,000; or

(3) Posted a surety bond in the amount of \$100,000.

[(b) Unless a licensee shows a net worth of more than \$1,000,000 at the time of application, the licensee must file a financial statement every 180 days.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

(House Bill 1202)

Water Pollution Control - Cost Sharing

FOR the purpose of establishing a cost sharing program for certain agricultural--practices--approved--to--control pollution--caused--by--sediment--and--animal--wastes;--setting limits--on--the--amount--of--cost--sharing--funds--that--may--be provided--to--an--operating--farm--unit;--establishing eligibility--requirements;--providing--that--the--Soil Conservation--District--shall--implement--the--cost--sharing program;--requiring--a--recipient--of--cost--sharing--funds--to maintain--the--agricultural--practice--in--good--operating conditions;--providing--that--a--person--may--not--be--liable for--the--failure--of--a--cost--shared--practice--under--certain circumstances;--and--generally--relating--to--a--soil conservation--cost--sharing--program: projects to control nonpoint source agriculturally related water pollution
