

(1) Pays the application fee required by the Board under § 16-303 of this subtitle; and

(2) Provides adequate evidence that the applicant:

(i) Meets the qualifications otherwise required by this title; and

(ii) Became licensed or certified in the other state under requirements substantially equivalent to the [certification] LICENSING requirements of this title.

16-310.

(a) (1) The Board shall place a licensee on inactive status, if the licensee submits to the Board:

(i) An application for inactive status on the form required by the Board; and

(ii) The inactive status fee set by the Board.

(2) The Board shall [certify] LICENSE an individual on inactive status who applies for [certification] A LICENSE and may not require payment of a late fee by the individual as a condition to [certification] LICENSING at that time.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

FOR the purpose of requiring the Montgomery County Housing Opportunities Commission to hold a public hearing ~~in the vicinity of a proposed housing project by a certain time, providing that the hearing be publicized and for assisted family housing by a certain time and providing~~
