

(3) THE DIVISION SHALL FORWARD ANY PROPERTY OR PAYMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COURT'S ORDER AND THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION TO:

- (I) THE VICTIM;
- (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY; OR
- (III) THE THIRD-PARTY PAYOR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 478

(House Bill 141)

AN ACT concerning

Juvenile Causes - Restitution - Hearing Date

FOR the purpose of providing that a restitution hearing to determine the liability of a parent or a child, or both, for a delinquent act of the child shall be held within a certain time; providing for a certain extension; and generally relating to restitution hearings in juvenile causes.
