

(A) THE WSSC MAY:

(1) ENTER ON A PUBLIC ROADWAY TO INSTALL, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE THE WSSC SYSTEM; AND

(2) CONSTRUCT A WATER MAIN, SEWER, OR DRAIN OR ANY APPURTENANCE OF A WATER MAIN, SEWER, OR DRAIN IN A PUBLIC ROADWAY:

(I) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, WITHOUT THE RECEIPT OF A PERMIT OR PAYMENT OF A CHARGE; AND

(II) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, SUBJECT TO THE PERMIT AND REGULATION PROVISIONS OF §§ 10-102 AND 10-103 OF THIS TITLE.

(B) IF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IS TO BE DISTURBED, THE WSSC SHALL:

(1) NOTIFY THE STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY THAT HAS AUTHORITY OVER THE PUBLIC ROADWAY OF THE WSSC'S PLANS;

(2) REPAIR AND LEAVE THE PUBLIC ROADWAY IN THE SAME OR A SUPERIOR CONDITION TO THAT EXISTING BEFORE THE PUBLIC ROADWAY WAS DISTURBED BY THE WSSC;

(3) BEAR ALL COSTS FOR RETURNING THE PUBLIC ROADWAY TO THE CONDITION REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

10-102. Special Right of Entry Procedures in Montgomery County.

(A) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL MAY ADOPT REASONABLE REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE WSSC'S ENTRY INTO OR USE OF ANY PUBLIC ROADWAY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY FOR WHICH A PERMIT IS REQUIRED.

(B) THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) MAY NOT BE INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE;

(2) SHALL BE ADOPTED AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE WSSC;

(3) SUBJECT TO REASONABLE PROVISIONS FOR CONTROL BY MONTGOMERY COUNTY OF THE CONSTRUCTION, DISTURBING, OR REPAIR OF THE PUBLIC ROADWAYS:
