

(8) PUBLIC AND PRIVATE GROUPS THAT ARE INTERESTED IN CORRECTIONS, RECREATION, VETERANS AFFAIRS, PUBLIC WELFARE, PAROLE, EDUCATION, LABOR, POLICE, YOUTH, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL, CIVIL SERVICE, MENTAL HEALTH, MEDICINE, PSYCHOLOGY, HEALTH AND LIFE INSURANCE, POVERTY PROGRAMS, EMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, AND LEGAL AID; AND

(9) OTHER PRIVATE AND PUBLIC AGENCIES.

(C) CONTENTS.

IN PROPOSING REVISIONS OF THE STATE PLAN AND IN CARRYING OUT THIS TITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

(1) SPECIFY HOW TO MAKE USE OF THE RESOURCES OF THE GROUPS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND OTHER RESOURCES; AND

(2) TRY TO USE THE FUNDS, PROGRAMS, AND FACILITIES THAT ARE AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL LAW.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that combines, without substantive change, former Article 2C, §§ 301(b)(9), 401, and 402.

In subsection (b) of this section, the former reference to the "Baltimore Area Council on Alcoholism, Inc." is deleted as obsolete.

Former Article 2C, §§ 401 and 402 required the development of a State plan and could be interpreted as obsolete since that plan was developed. However, this section is revised to reflect that the "plan for inclusion in the comprehensive health plan ...", submitted to the Governor under former Article 2C, § 301(b)(9), is a reference to proposed revisions to the State plan originally developed under former Article 2C, §§ 401 and 402 and that, in developing the proposals, the Administration follows the requirements of those former sections.

8-402. STATE PROGRAM.

(A) PROGRAM REQUIRED.

THIS STATE SHALL HAVE A TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM THAT:

(1) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, IS COORDINATED WITH THE PROGRAMS OF COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTERS AND USES THEIR FACILITIES; AND
