(III) EACH LICENSEE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY THE TAX DUE TO THE STATE BY DEPOSITING THE AMOUNT OF THE TAX AT THE TIMES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B) (2) (I) IN A DEPOSITORY DESIGNATED BY THE STATE TREASURER. THE LICENSEE SHALL SEND A STATEMENT TO THE COMMISSION SHOWING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WAGERED AND THE AMOUNT OF THE STATE TAX DEPOSITED.

The Maryland Racing Commission is hereby authorized to pay over to the Maryland Horsemen's Assistance Fund, Inc., a charitable corporation organized for the benefit, aid, assistance and relief of horsemen, trainers, jockeys, exercise riders, grooms, stable attendants and other persons employed in connection with the racing of horses or their spouses or children, who are in need of financial assistance, for these aforementioned corporate purposes, and no other purpose, all moneys held by the Maryland Racing Commission on June 1, 1949 in a special fund known as the Relief Fund of the Maryland Racing Commission as created by Chapter 786, Laws of 1947, and all fines and penalties and overpayments on the tote machines hereafter collected, except the fines and penalties as may be imposed upon associations.
