

(D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

(1) A STUDENT OF CHIROPRACTIC WHILE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED CHIROPRACTOR ENGAGED IN AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM:

(I) SPONSORED BY A COLLEGE ACCREDITED BY THE COUNCIL ON CHIROPRACTIC EDUCATION; AND

(II) APPROVED BY THE BOARD; OR

(2) AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC IN ANY OTHER STATE OR A FOREIGN COUNTRY WHILE THAT INDIVIDUAL MAKES A CLINICAL DEMONSTRATION BEFORE:

(I) A CHIROPRACTIC ASSOCIATION;

(II) A CHIROPRACTIC CONVENTION; OR

(III) A CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 431

(House Bill 607)

AN ACT concerning

Criminal Investigations - Subpoenas

FOR the purpose of ~~altering--the--State's-Attorney's-power-to subpoena-witnesses-and-require-the-production-of-records--in a--criminal--investigation;~~ repealing certain provisions regarding the State's Attorney's power to issue a certain summons under certain circumstances; providing that the State's Attorneys may issue certain subpoenas to persons to require the production of telephone, business, government, or corporate records or documents under certain circumstances; providing for the imposition of penalties if a-witness-fails-to-obey-a-subpoena; by a circuit court after a hearing; providing for a certain right to counsel and notice; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the issuance of subpoenas in a criminal investigation.

BY adding to
