SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 73B - Pensions

The following words and phrases as used in this article, unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall have the following meanings:

(16) "Annuity" shall mean payments for life derived from the accumulated contributions of a member. All annuities shall be payable in equal monthly installments, EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY RULE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AS AN ACTUARIALLY EQUIVALENT BENEFIT PROVIDED UNDER THE OPTION 4 ALLOWANCE.

(17) "Pension" shall mean payments for life derived from money provided by the State. All pensions shall be payable in equal monthly installments, EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY RULE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AS AN ACTUARIALLY EQUIVALENT BENEFIT PROVIDED UNDER THE OPTION 4 ALLOWANCE.
