SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

(1) (1) "HABILITATION" MEANS ~~THE--DEGREE--AND--TYPE--OF~~ EDUCATION, ~~TRAINING,~~ ~~AND--CARE--REQUIRED--BY--A--MENTALLY--RETARDED--OR~~ ~~NONRETARDED--DEVELOPMENTALLY--DISABLED--INDIVIDUAL--TO--REACH--THE~~ ~~INDIVIDUAL'S--MAXIMUM--DEVELOPMENT.~~ A PROCESS BY WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL ACQUIRES AND MAINTAINS THOSE LIFE SKILLS THAT ENABLE THE INDIVIDUAL TO COPE MORE EFFECTIVELY WITH THE DEMANDS OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S OWN PERSON AND ENVIRONMENT AND TO RAISE THE LEVEL OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S PHYSICAL, MENTAL, AND SOCIAL FUNCTIONING.

(2) "HABILITATION" INCLUDES PROGRAMS OF TREATMENT WHICH PROVIDE TRAINING AND SELF-HELP, DAILY LIVING, SURVIVAL, AND PRE-VOCATIONAL SKILLS.
