(C-1) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, A RENEWAL OF A LICENSE MAY NOT BE GRANTED, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, IF THE LICENSEE OR ANY OF THE STOCKHOLDERS OF THE CORPORATION HAVING THE USE OF A LICENSE HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF A FELONY. OR--WHO--DURING--THE LICENSE--YEAR-HAVE-BEEN-CONVICTED-OF-ANY-OFFENSE-AGAINST-THE-LAWS OF-THE-STATE-OR-OF-THE-UNITED-STATES-WHICH-IN-THE-JUDGMENT-OF-THE LOCAL-LICENSING-OFFICIALS-IS-OF-THE-NATURE-THAT-WOULD-RENDER--THE HOLDER--UNFIT--OR--WOULD-DISQUALIFY-THE-LICENSEE-FROM-OBTAINING-A LICENSE-RENEWAL. (f) (5) In addition to the above, the board may revoke the license of a licensee for:

(i) [Conviction of a felony] A FELONY CONVICTION OF A LICENSEE OR ANY STOCKHOLDER OF A CORPORATION HAVING THE USE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE; or
