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#### CHAPTER 688

(House Bill 1446)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Glen Burnie Urban Renewal

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$2,000,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the governing body of Anne Arundel County for the purpose of assisting in the urban renewal effort by construction of a parking facility to improve the parking arrangements of the Arundel Center North Building; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Glen Burnie Urban Renewal Loan of 1983 in the aggregate principal amount of ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$2,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
