Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 623.

This bill repeals the provision that will terminate, after a certain date, the authority granted to Anne Arundel County to levy a sales or use tax on certain goods and services.

Senate Bill 617, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 31, 1983, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 623.

House Bill No. 623

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Taxing Powers

FOR the purpose of repealing the provision that will terminate, after a certain date, the authority granted to Anne Arundel County to levy a sales or use tax on certain goods and services.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes  
Section 411C  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1980 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes

411C.

(a) The County Council for Anne Arundel may by ordinance levy, impose, and collect a sales or use tax upon the goods and services specified in this section.
