Pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-11 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the State Administrative Board of Election Laws does hereby certify that at the General Election held in the State of Maryland on November 2, 1982, an Act known as Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1982 was submitted to the voters of the State of Maryland under the provisions of Article XIV of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, said Act being as follows:

AN ACT concerning Imprisonment for Debt. For the purpose of eliminating a gender-specific reference in the Maryland Constitution and replacing it with a gender-neutral reference in certain provisions pertaining to imprisonment for debt; clarifying and specifying the meaning of the term "alimony"; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 514,402 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 321 and 185,391 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 321 the said Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1982 has therefore been ratified.
